**P**ULAI Springs Resort is celebrating Secretaries Week with a week-long food and beverage promotion until Friday.

Gleneagles Terrace Restaurant is offering a choice of two special "East meets West" Secretaries Week set menus from noon to 2.30pm.

The first choice is a RM75++ four-course luncheon which includes *kyuri wakame*, a seaweed and cu-

cumber salad served with Japanese salad sauce, and tom yam kung, a Thai red-spiced soup with prawns and lemon grass for starters.

The main dish in this set is a choice of either "Godzilla" — a grilled rib eye with carrots, siew pak choy and mashed potatoes served with teriyaki sauce or *Nord-sea*, a pan-fried fillet of sea bass with sauteed potatoes and creamy lemon sauce.

To end the meal, a fruity *paylova* is served with coffee or tea.

The second choice is a RM90++ five-course set menu which includes the Langkasuka salad — a fresh tossed salad with crispy bean cake and lettuce, *otak-otak* with special homemade dressing and mixed melon berries sherbet for starters.

For the main course, secretaries will be given a choice of D'Glenea-

gles Steak, a char-grilled beef sirloin with mixed mushroom and mashed potatoes served with Cajun sauce or *ikan bakar semenanjung*, which is baked fish filled in banana leaves with special *ikan bakar bakar* served with white rice and sauteed vegetables.

The dessert served is a warm chocolate brownie with butterscotch sauce and icecream served with coffee or tea.
