

SOPs for POOL USE



While You Are Here, PLEASE FOLLOW OUR NEW GUIDELINES

- 1. Please ensure that you have scanned your details using MySejahtera App or scan the QR code using your QR Code Reader when registering at the Sports Centre.
- 2. You are also required to record down your name, telephone number and body temperature. Anyone with temperature above 37.5 Degrees Celsius will not be allowed to use the pools.
- 3. Please use hand sanitizer provided at the counter.
- 4. Number of pool users are limited and remain at minimal for each session depending on the size of our swimming pool due to social distancing.
- 5. Number of pool users are limited to FOUR (4) persons per pool at one time. Maximum pool use is one (1) hour only per person. If you wish to continue after one (1) hour, please refer to the Sports & Recreation counter.
- 6. Only persons with proper attire will be allowed in the pool. Please refer to our pool rules and regulations on display near the pool area.
- 7. Please shower before entering the swimming pool. You are also required to shower and clean yourself up after your swim before entering the changing room.
- 8. Social distancing of 1 2 meters is to be observed. Social distancing during static activities is at 1 3 meters and for dynamic activities is at 3 5 meters.
- 9. Number of users at the shower and fitting rooms to be kept at minimum too. Additional facilities such as the sauna and Jacuzzi are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- You are encouraged to bring your own towels, however, pool towels are still available at the counter.
- 11. Anyone with contagious diseases and skin disease is strictly prohibited to enter the swimming pool.
- 12. Children aged below 6 years and senior citizens above 60 years are not advisable to use the pool, however you may still use at your own risk.
- 13. To those who do not comply to the above SOPs, the Management reserves the right to ask you to leave the pool area immediately.
- 14. The Resort Management also reserves the right to close the pool without further notice should the situation becomes out of control with many reports of non-compliance.
